**Planning Commission:** Act 537 Special Study – Worcester Township has approved a study of an expansion and proposed pumping station in two Fairview Village areas. 1) Off Adair Drive near Methacton High School 2) Off Mill & Valley Forge Road near the Hugenir subdivision.
